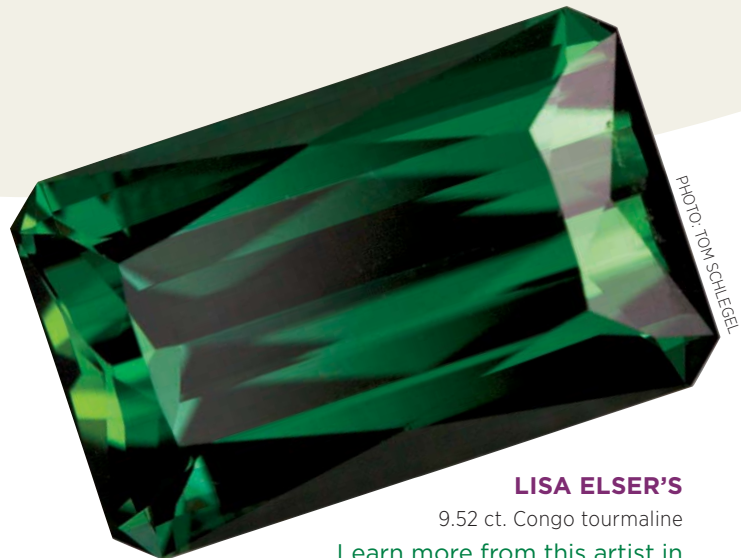


**MONA & ALEX SZABADOS'S
